

Minute on ICE agents' access to houses of worship

On February 9, 2025, Meeting for Worship approved the following **Minute**.

Red Cedar Friends (Quakers) in Lansing, Michigan, oppose the immigration policy allowing Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents to enter houses of worship in search of undocumented folks for potential deportation.

For over 200 years, Quakers have steadfastly believed in the equality and humanity of all people. As stated by Philadelphia Yearly Meeting "Our faith requires us to do justice, oppose war and violence, love our neighbors (with no exceptions) and to make decisions with everyone in the room. Everyone's faith requires being with their faith family. The DHS policy impedes all of these things and invades our sacred space and ability to worship freely.
